### *Incident: Health Advisory #13*

This is a civil defense message.

This is a health advisory update for **Tuesday evening, April 22, at 4 o'clock.**

Normal trade wind weather continues through this evening and tomorrow morning. However, the National Weather Service has forecasted that wind speed may decrease and wind direction may shift to an east south easterly direction beginning mid-day tomorrow, Wednesday, April 23. This may bring weather conditions similar to previous weeks that brought vog into the Puna and Hilo areas.

Currently, the district of Ka'u is in the YELLOW Color Code status, indicating light levels of sulfur dioxide. All other districts are in Color Code Green.

The weather, sulfur dioxide, and vog conditions will be monitored closely and if conditions change that might affect your safety you will be informed.
