Emergency Health Advisory #19

This is a Civil Defense message.

This is a health advisory for **Saturday morning April 26 at 8 o'clock.**

The National Weather Service forecasts that tradewinds are returning and will continue to strengthen through the weekend. Based on the wind forecast, field observations, and current sulfur dioxide measurements the following public safety advisories and recommendations are made:

- Because the District of Ka'u is downwind of Kilauea volcano during normal tradewinds, Ka'u is under Color Code YELLOW status. Under Color Code YELLOW those in sensitive groups should avoid outdoor activity.
- All other districts are currently in Color Code GREEN
- The Hawai'i Volcanoes National Park is open today.

Again, the district of Ka'u is under Color Code Yellow status. All other districts are in Color Code Green.

The sulfur dioxide and wind conditions are being closely monitored and if any changes occur that might affect your safety, you will be informed and updates will be issued as necessary.

This will be the last scheduled update unless conditions change.
