Emergency Health and Weather Advisory #21

This is a Civil Defense message.

This is a health and weather advisory for Tuesday morning, May 13 at 6 o'clock.

The National Weather Service has forecasted that normal tradewinds for the island of Hawai'i will diminish today and be replaced by light and variable winds.

Due to the forecasted wind change the following public safety advisories are issued:

- ❖ The absence of tradewinds has generally impacted most districts of the Big Island with vog.
- ❖ All Big Island residents should anticipate increased vog with special care to those in the sensitive group.

Again, all Big Island residents should anticipate increased vog due to the absence of tradewinds beginning today.

Air quality and weather conditions are being closely monitored and if any changes occur that might affect your safety you will be informed.

The next scheduled update will be tomorrow morning by 6 o'clock
